

General Guidance	 Following cleaning instructions, ensure all parts are clean before first use. Craster recommends stirring the product before filling dispenser. Refill the dispenser when the product stops dispensing consistently. This product is designed to dispense smooth yoghurt. It is NOT suitable for other products. As standard, the pump will deliver a 1 fl oz (28.4ml) portion. Clean, rinse, sanitise, and dry parts daily or regularly to comply with local requirements.


- Clean, rinse, sanitise, and dry parts daily or regularly to comply with local requirements.
- Freeze the Freezer Packs for at least 4 hours prior to use. Handle with care when frozen; wear insulated gloves to avoid frostburn.





1. Before first use, dismantle the pump and properly wash, rinse and sanitise all components. See page 5 for detailed cleaning instructions.


Install O-ring into the seal , and install onto the piston head . Apply food-safe lubricant . In the outside of the seal. Then slide the washer . and the spring . onto the piston.




3. Slide the locking nut 2 towards the flared end of the head tube 6. Slide the head insert 6 into head tube. Then insert the piston assembly into the head tube assembly.




5. Fit the large O-ring 2 into the valve body 3. Apply food-safe lubricant onto the O-ring.



7. Install the medium O-ring 20 onto the discharge tube. Apply food-safe lubricant on the O-ring. Then install the discharge tube onto the valve body.






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3a. This step is only required if you wish to adjust the pump's serving volume.


Add the required gaging collars onto the head tube (5). Adding the small collar (3) will result in a 1/8 fl oz volume reduction. Adding the large collar (4) will result in a 1/4 fl oz volume reduction. Gaging collars can be used in combination.




4. To install the knob **()**, press the head tube down to compress the spring and expose the piston threads. Rotate the knob clockwise to secure.



6. Install the cylinder 1 onto the valve body.



8. Install the lid (2) by sliding the smaller lid hole over the discharge tube and aligning the centre hole with the threads on the cylinder. Secure the discharge tube with the nut. Finally, install the plunger assembly into the cylinder, rotating the locking collar clockwise onto the cylinder threads to secure.



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
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

1. Place the Drip Tray and Bowl Stand into the front slot of the Base Board.




3. Place the frozen Freezer Packs inside of the Outer Vessel chamber.




- ${\bf 5}.$ Ensure the Inner Vessel tabs are oriented as shown. Then fill with your chosen product.



4. Lower the Inner Vessel into the Outer Vessel.



6. Lower the pump and lid assembly into the Inner Vessel. Ensure the end of the Discharge Tube is aligned with the Bowl Stand's central hole.

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
Clean-In-Place

1. Pump out any remaining yoghurt inside the pump body. Wash and rinse the inside and outside of the pump.

2. Place the lower end of the pump into a container full of warm water and dishwasher detergent. Operate the pump until all remaining product is expelled and only warm water flows from discharge tube.


To sanitise the pump, replace dishwasher detergent with your chosen sanitiser.

3. Replace the cleaning mixture with hot water and operate the pump until all water is expelled. Leave parts to air dry.



Cleaning

- To keep the pump safe and in good working order, it is important to clean, rinse, sanitise, and dry parts daily or regularly.
- Both the pump and knob are suitable for dishwasher cleaning.
- More thorough cleaning can be conducted with the pump disassembled, using the brushes provided. See the below illustrations for direction.



Troubleshooting

Problems with flow or portions:

- Clean the pump.
- Yoghurt may be too thick or contain a solid that cannot pass through the pump.
- If used, ensure the gaging collar(s) are undamanged and properly installed.

Plunger not returning to top after dispensing:

- Ensure that the spring is functional. Replace if broken.
- Ensure that the washer is installed between the spring and piston head.

Pump is dripping:

- Yoghurt may be too thin.
- Thoroughly clean the discharge tube with the supplied tube brush.
- Inspect all o-rings and replace if damaged.

Yoghurt oozes out around locking collar:

 Ensure seal is properly installed on the piston. This has a slight taper; ensure this is installed with the flat side facing upwards and the flared side downwards.

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
